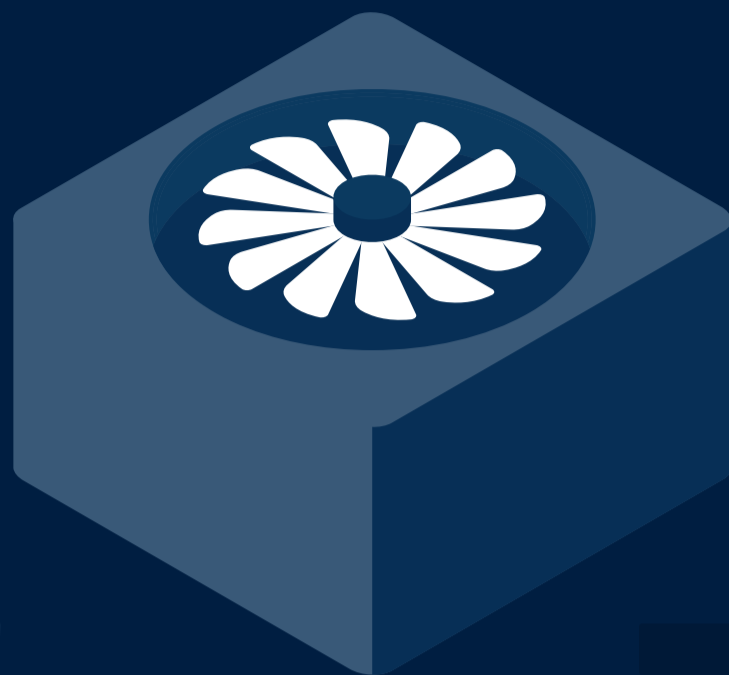


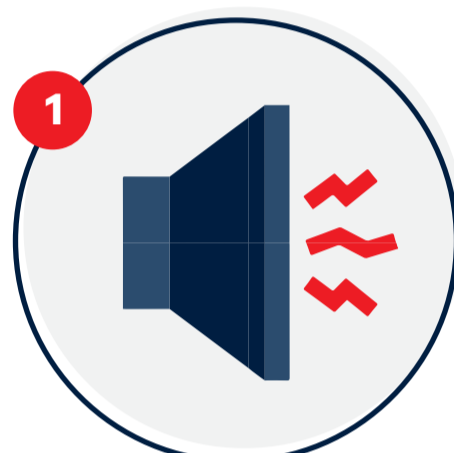
FIX OR REPLACE?

5 SIGNS IT MAY BE TIME TO REPLACE YOUR AIR CONDITIONER



UNUSUAL NOISES

Can you hear noises from your air conditioner that don't seem normal? Or is it making too much noise? An old or worn out A/C tends to be noisy, and such sounds indicate that you will soon need to replace it.



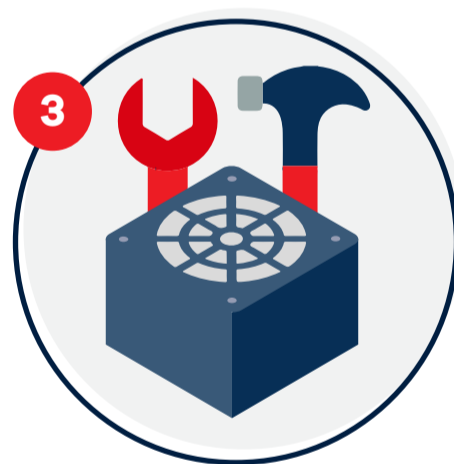
UNEVEN COOLING

Your A/C will likely not cool your home evenly when it is approaching its end. If you have observed that some parts of your living spaces are seemingly cool while others are not, it may be time to replace your A/C unit.



YOU ARE CALLING FREQUENTLY FOR REPAIRS

While it is normal for your A/C unit to need timely repairs to run efficiently, when you call more than twice in 12 months for a repair, it may be time to consider replacing it.



FLUID LEAKS

HVAC repairs can fix a coolant leakage. However, if you notice large water pools around your A/C unit or an out-of-control coolant leakage, replacing the system with a newer, more efficient one could be wise.



YOUR A/C IS OVER 10 YEARS OLD

Did you know that replacing your more than ten-year-old A/C unit with a newer, more efficient model can save approximately 20% to 40% of your cooling energy costs? Typically, A/C units feature a life span of 10 years to 15 years on average.
